SOURCE PROTECTION COMMITTEE (SPC) MEETING

May 31, 2018 at Asphodel-Norwood Community Centre, Norwood.

New SPC Member

- Chair Hunt introduced Kristin Muskratt to the committee. Kristin is from Curve Lake First Nation and is the coordinator of the Youth For Water (Y4W) program.

Correspondence

- 6 items of correspondence were received by the Committee. The Chair discussed the letters written to both the former and current Minister of Environment and Climate Change regarding appreciation from Source Protection Committee Chairs.

SPC Outreach Strategy

- Committee members were provided with speaking notes and a list of resources for sector engagements.
- Staff also provided committee members with an overview of the provincial mapping tool (<http://www.applications.ene.gov.on.ca/swp/en/index.php>) and the TCC Map available from the TCC Homepage (<http://trentsourceprotection.on.ca>).

Minister's Annual Report on Drinking Water 2017

- Staff presented an updated staff report regarding the Minister's Annual Report on Drinking Water 2017. The report made it clear the review showed no *Clean Water Act* "issues" with respect to chemicals in the treated water

O. Reg. 205/18 (Amendments to the Safe Drinking Water Act, 2002)

- Staff presented to the committee with the regulation amendments. As of July 1, 2018 a municipal residential drinking water system owner cannot (a) apply for a drinking water works permit/licence without a specific notice from a SPA, and (b) supply treated water to the public until the updated Source Protection Plan is approved by MOECC

Section 36 Work Plan

- Staff walked the committee through the timelines, rationale and chapters in the draft Trent and Ganaraska workplans. Highlights include new or amended systems, new vulnerable area mapping, updates to reflect technical rule changes for above ground fuel storage and conveyance of oil by pipeline, policy effectiveness, implementation challenges, and enabling provisions.
- Committee members were asked to provide questions in advance of the next meeting, where the Committee will review the workplan and subsequent details of the proposed updates.
